

Parents Code of Conduct

- Remember, children participate in Junior Rugby League for their enjoyment not yours
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance, rather than winning or losing
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game
- Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good performance by all participants
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from Rugby League
- Show appreciation of volunteers, coaches, officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate
- Respect the referees decision and teach children to do likewise
- The consumption of alcohol outside of licenced areas and smoking at the school or at our groups is prohibited
- Under no circumstances are any person, other than water runners, touch judges and first aiders, allowed to enter the area of play
- Ignorance of the Code of Conduct will be no defence if someone has broken this Code of Conduct
